It is the responsibility of each participant to file the appropriate paperwork with your state bar(s) for continuing legal education credit for this course.

CLE accreditation is granted on a state-by-state basis. Each state has its own rules and regulations that define eligible course content for CLE credit. Due to varying state bar approval procedures, we cannot foresee how many credits the workshop will be approved for; however, this course is typically accredited for 13-19 CLE credits.
